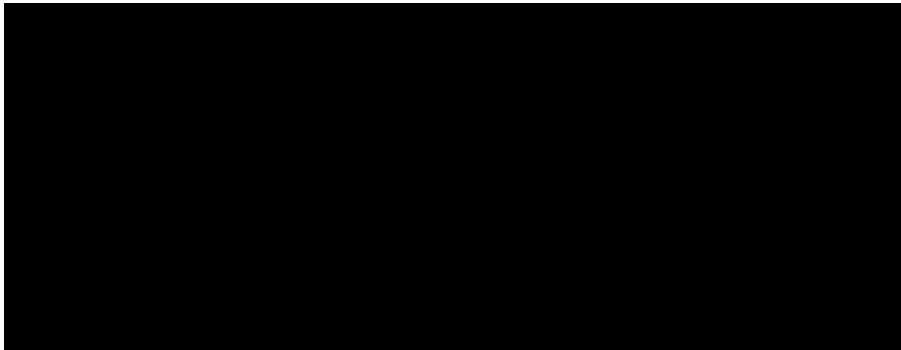

#### **1. Scope**

The scope of this task is to deliver a program management system of support sufficient to meet the specific performance requirements described in this document during the period of performance (PoP) for this task to the Common Aviation Command and Control System (CAC2S), Composite Tracking Network (CTN), Marine Air Command and Control Systems (MACCS) Sustainment Portfolio of Systems (PoS), and Theater Battle Management Core System (TBMCS) programs.

To support this task, the Contractor shall collect and provide specified information, conduct specified tailored analyses and structure reviews of Government and Prime System Contractor data, develop and maintain specified Acquisition management tools/data bases, and facilitate the development and completion of specified acquisition documents/briefings/reports. The outcome of this effort shall be the timely delivery of quality products to support the mission of the AC2SN PM.

#### **1.1 Background**

The mission of Program Manager (PM) AC2SN is to act as the central agent for the research, development, production, deployment, and life cycle management of Air Command and Control (AC2) for the Marine Corps Operating Forces and Supporting Establishments in accordance with the Department of Defense (DoD) 5000 acquisition process.

##### **1.1.1 CAC2S**

CAC2S is a Major Automated Information System (MAIS), Acquisition Category (ACAT) IAC program which is a modernization effort to replace the existing AC2 equipment of the MACCS and to provide the Aviation Combat Element (ACE) with the necessary hardware, software, equipment, and facilities to effectively command and control the six functions of Marine Aviation. CAC2S will accomplish the MACCS missions with a suite of operationally scalable modules to support the Marine Air-Ground Task Force (MAGTF), Joint, and Coalition Forces. CAC2S integrates the six functions of Marine Aviation into an interoperable system that will support the core competencies of all Marine Corps war-fighting concepts. CAC2S, in conjunction with MACCS organic sensors and weapon systems, supports the tenets of Expeditionary Maneuver Warfare (EMW) and fosters Joint interoperability.

The CAC2S Increment I is structured such that Phase 1 accommodated the rapid fielding of

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operationally relevant capabilities to include mobility, situational awareness, tactical communications, information dissemination, and operational flexibility.

Phase 1 focus is on the sustainment of fielded capability and the development of necessary enhancements through the Engineering Change Proposal (ECP) process to address configuration item obsolesces and/or discrepancies encountered within the operational forces and supporting establishments.

Phase 2 is structured to accommodate the integration of sensor data, processing, and display technologies necessary for the CAC2S to meet remaining ACE Battle Management and Command and Control requirements. Phase 2 activities include but are not limited to the following: Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM)/contractor and government Development Testing (DTs); integrated logistics support (ILS) for Milestone C (MS-C) and Operational Testing (OT); cost estimates for budget submissions and a Service Cost Position (SCP) for MS-C and Phase 2 Full Deployment Review (FDR); acquisition documentation and briefings for MS-C review and FDR; and government Limited Deployment Unit (LDU) factory acceptance testing.

### **1.1.2 CTN**

The CTN is an ACAT III Program which provides cradle-to-grave support of the AN/MSQ-143. The CTN system, the United States Marine Corps (USMC) component of the Navy's Cooperative Engagement Capability (CEC), provides the USMC with a capability to produce accurate, composite, real-time surveillance tracks by correlating sensor measurement data from contributing radars. CTN provides a unique sensor netting capability by integrating air track data into host C2 platforms. The system is comprised of durable, scalable, and modular components that meet the expeditionary operational requirements of the Marine Corps. The CTN system is employed by the USMC MACCS, providing information to the CEC network that is derived from its organic sensors and information from other Service sensors to improve real-time Situational Awareness (SA).

The CTN is a stand-alone system comprised of commercial off the shelf (COTS) and non-developmental item (NDI) components that support USMC CEC operations. The core of the system is the AN/US-G4A/4B Signal Data Processor (SDP) and the Compact Solid State Antenna (CSSA).

The program is currently in the operational and sustainment phase with follow-on ECPs to modernize system capabilities. CTN activities include but are not limited to the following: procurement and fielding of the AN/MSQ-143A(V)1 and DT and operational assessments (OAs) with other USMC systems such as the AN/TPS-80 Ground/Air Task Oriented Radar (G/ATOR) and CAC2S; integration with the AN/TPS-59 Mode 5 testing and conducting a CTN software certification to support the AN/TPS-59 OT. The CTN program will also be implementing the Common Array Block-Expeditionary (CAB-E) Antenna in a partnership with PEO IWS-6, CEC. CTN Initial Operational Capability (IOC) was achieved in Fiscal Year (FY)11 and Full Operational Capability (FOC) is planned for FY16.

### **1.1.3 MACCS Sustainment (PoS)**

PM AC2SN is responsible for ensuring that the MACCS Sustainment PoS is sustained and fielded to Marine Corps Operating Forces within specific cost, schedule and performance parameters. MACCS Sustainment systems fall under Abbreviated Acquisition Programs (AAPs). The MACCS Sustainment

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Product Team (PT) provides for the life cycle support of systems organic to the Marine Air Control Group (MACG) and its subordinate units. The primary systems within the MACCS Sustainment PoS include: AN/TYQ-23(V)4, AN/TSQ-269, AN/TYQ-87(V)2, AN/MSQ-124, AN/TYQ-101A, AN/TYQ-145, AN/MRQ-13, AN/USQ-140(V)11C, AN/URC-107(V)10, and AN/GRC-171B(V)4. The primary focus of efforts for post MS-C fielded systems includes Post Deployment Software Support (PDSS), Commercial Off The Shelf (COTS) component refresh/redesign, system hardware sustainment, and general logistics sustainment/management.

The MACCS Sustainment PoS focus is on logistics and project management support for fielded systems, as well as maintaining configuration management of system changes generated by software and hardware improvements. Existing systems are undergoing assessments of component and system obsolescence and developing recommendations for extending the service life of the equipment. Some results of these assessments require multiple system modifications which will be managed as ECPs.

#### **1.1.4 TBMCS**

TBMCS is an ACAT III United States Air Force (USAF) lead program with joint interest and oversight for Air Tasking Order (ATO) interoperability. TBMCS is the air war planning tool for generation, dissemination and execution of the ATO and Airspace Control Order (ACO). TBMCS currently has 15 Computer Based Training (CBT) courses (i.e., modules) developed for fielded TBMCS applications. The CBT is accessible via MarineNet and is also available via (CDROM). CBT for the Marine Corps Air Mission Planner (MCAMP) application is currently being developed. The current courses are developed utilizing Adobe Flash, Adobe Photoshop, (XML), Javascript and (HTML). The MCAMP application which migrates the Unix based planning and replanning applications to a single web based application, is scheduled to complete development and be ready for fielding in May 2014. It is anticipated that the amount of change required for the CBT will not exceed 10% of the overall CBT lessons per annual update.

TBMCS in the Operations and Support phase of its acquisition lifecycle, with the focus of effort being on sustainment of the fielded system hardware and software and Information Assurance accreditation. PM AC2SN is responsible for all USMC TBMCS technical and support activities necessary to define, develop, and deploy operationally suitable and effective TBMCS releases for relevance and capability with the program baseline and schedule. Within this framework are requirements for implementation of technical capabilities that will ensure the interoperability of legacy Command and Control (C2) systems with the planned MAGTF C2 architecture.

## **2. Performance Requirements**

### **2.1. General Requirements**

Contractor employees shall identify themselves as contractor personnel by introducing themselves or being introduced as contractor personnel and displaying distinguishing badges or other visible identification for meetings with Government personnel. In addition, contractor personnel shall appropriately identify themselves as contractor employees in telephone conversations and in formal and informal written correspondence.

Reporting inputs will be for the labor executed during the period of performance during each Government fiscal year (FY), which runs October 1 through September 30. While inputs may be reported any time during the FY, all data shall be reported no later than October 31 of each calendar year. #### 4.0 Security Requirements



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The contractor shall have a valid Secret Facility Clearance with established Secret Safeguarding (verifiable in the Industrial Security Facilities Database (ISFD)), prior to classified performance or classified meetings at other contractor or Government locations and SIPRNET access. All Contractors performing on classified aspects of this contract shall have a current Secret Clearance and will be required to maintain access to Secret Information. CACs are not issued for convenience.

The contractor shall notify the Government (written notice) within twenty-four hours of any contractor personnel added or removed from the contract that have been granted classified access, issued a Common Access Card and/or MARCORSYSCOM Building access.

If a contractor employee's open investigation closes and is not favorably adjudicated, the CAC must be immediately retrieved and revoked. Facility Security Officers are responsible for notifying the MCSC Security Director if any contractor performing on this contract receives an unfavorable adjudication after being issued a CAC. Contractor CACs are issued with a "ctr.usmc.mil" e-mail account that the individual contractor is responsible to keep active by logging in on a regular basis (at least twice a month), sending an e-mail and clearing any unneeded e-mails. Contractors are prohibited from "auto-forwarding" their .mil e-mail account to their .com e-mail account.

(h) Nothing in this clause affects the right of the Government to this contract pursuant to the clause of this contract entitled "TERMINATION FOR CONVENIENCE OF THE GOVERNMENT."

(i) Nothing in this clause shall be construed as authorization of voluntary services whose acceptance is otherwise prohibited under 31 U.S.C. 1342.

(j) The parties contemplate that the Government will allot funds to this contract in accordance with the following schedule:

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## SECTION H SPECIAL CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS

### SECTION H. SPECIAL CONTRACT PROVISIONS.

#### H.1 Contracting Officer's Representative (COR)

The Contracting Officer has designated a Contracting Officer's Representative in accordance with DFARS 201.602-2 (2). The COR is not authorized to negotiate changes, direct the contractor, or obligate the Government.

The COR for this task order is:



All Contract Data Requirements List (CDRL) deliverables are to be submitted to the COR, and the COR is responsible for tracking and acceptance.

#### H. 2 Identification of Contractor Employees

Contractor employees shall identify themselves as contractor personnel by introducing themselves or being introduced as contractor personnel and displaying distinguishing badges or other visible identification for meetings with Government personnel. In addition contractor personnel shall appropriately identify themselves as contractor employees in telephone conversations and in formal and informal written correspondence.

#### H.3 Organizational Conflict of Interest (OCI)

Limitation of Future Contracting. The Contracting Officer has determined that this acquisition may give rise to a potential conflict of interest. Prospective Offerors should read FAR Subpart 9.5 -- Organizational and Consultant Conflicts of Interest. This task may involve systems engineering and technical direction for the Air Command and Control and Sensor Netting program that will preclude Contractor involvement in future efforts. The restrictions upon future contracting are as follows:

- If the Contractor, under the terms of this task order, or through the performance of tasks pursuant to this task order, is required to provide systems engineering and technical direction for a system or helps to develop specifications or statements of work to be used in a competitive acquisition, the Contractor shall be ineligible to supply the system or major components of the system as a prime Contractor and shall be precluded from being a Subcontractor or consultant to a supplier of the system or any of its major components under an ensuing Government contract. This restriction shall remain in effect for a reasonable time, sufficient to avoid unfair competitive advantage or potential bias (this time shall in no case be less than the duration of the initial production contract).

To the extent that the work under this contract requires access to proprietary, business confidential, or financial data of other companies, and as long as these data remain proprietary or confidential, the Contractor shall protect the data from unauthorized use and disclosure and agrees not to use it to compete with those other companies.

(a) "Organizational Conflict of Interest" means that because of other activities or relationships with other persons, a person is unable or potentially unable to render impartial assistance or advice to the government, or the person's objectivity in performing the contract work is or might be otherwise impaired, or a person has an unfair competitive advantage. "Person" as used herein includes corporations, partnerships, joint ventures, and other business enterprises.

(b) The contractor warrants that to the best of its knowledge and belief, and except as otherwise set forth in the contract, the contractor does not have any organizational conflict of interest(s) as defined in paragraph (a).

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(c) It is recognized that the effort to be performed by the Contractor under this contract may create a potential organizational conflict of interest on the instant contract or on a future acquisition. In order to avoid potential conflict of interest, and at the same time to avoid prejudicing the best interest of the government, the right of the contractor to participate in future procurement of equipment and/or services that are the subject of any work under this contract shall be limited as described below in accordance with the requirements of FAR 9.5.

(d)(1) The contractor agrees that it shall not release, disclose, or use in any way that would permit or result in disclosure to any party outside the government any information provided to the contract by the government during or as a result of performance of this contract. Such information includes, but is not limited to, information submitted to the government on confidential basis by other persons. Further, the prohibition against release of government provided information extends to cover such information whether or not in its original form, e.g., where the information has been included in contractor generated work or where it is discernible from materials incorporating or based upon such information. This prohibition shall not expire after a given period of time.

(2) The contractor agrees that it shall not release, disclose, or use in any way that would permit or result in disclosure or any party outside the government any information generated or derived during or as a result of performance of this contract. This prohibition shall expire after a period of three years after completion of performance of this contract.

(3) The prohibitions contained in subparagraphs (d)(1) and (d)(2) shall apply with equal force to any affiliate of the contractor, any subcontractor, consultant, or employee of the contractor, any joint venture involving the contractor, any entity into or with which it may merge or affiliate, or any successor or assign of the contractor. The terms of paragraph (f) of the Special Contractor Requirement relating to notification shall apply to any release of information in contravention of this paragraph (d).

(e) The contractor further agrees that during the performance of this contract and for a period of three years after completion of performance of this contract, the contractor, any affiliate of the contractor, any subcontractor, consultant, or employee of the contractor, any joint venture involving the contractor, any entity into or with which it may subsequently merge or affiliate or any other successor or assign of the contractor, shall not furnish to the United States Government, either as a prime contractor or as a subcontractor, or as a consultant to a prime contractor or as a subcontractor, any system, component or services which is the subject of the work to be performed under this contract. This exclusion does not apply to any re-competition for those systems, components, or services on the basis of work statements growing out of the effort performed under this contract, from a source other than the contractor, subcontractor affiliate, or assign of either, during the course of performance of this contract or before the three year period following completion of this contract has lapsed, the contractor may, with the authorization of the cognizant contracting officer, participate in a subsequent procurement for the same system, component, or service. In other words, the contractor may be authorized to compete for procurement(s) for systems, components or services subsequent to an intervening procurement.

(f) The contractor agrees that, if after award, it discovers an actual or potential organizational conflict of interest; it shall make immediate and full disclosure in writing to the contracting officer. The notification shall include a description of the actual or potential organizational conflict of interest, a description of the action, which the contractor has taken or proposes to take to avoid, mitigate, or neutralize the conflict, and any other relevant information that would assist the contracting officer in making a determination on this matter. Notwithstanding this notification, the government may terminate the contract for the convenience of the government if determined to be in the best interest of the government.

(g) Notwithstanding paragraph (f) above, if the contractor was aware, or should have been aware, of an organizational conflict of interest prior to the award of this contract or becomes, or should become aware of an organizational conflict of interest after award of this contract and does not make an immediate and full disclosure in writing to the contracting officer, the government may terminate this contract for default.

(h) If the contractor takes any action prohibited by this requirement or fails to take action required by this requirement, the government may terminate this contract by default.

(i) The contracting officer's decision as to the existence or nonexistence of the actual or potential organization conflict of interest shall be final and is not subject to the clause of this contract entitled "DISPUTES" (FAR

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52.233.1).

(j) Nothing in this requirement is intended to prohibit or preclude the contractor from marketing or selling to the United States Government its product lines in existence on the effective date of this contract; nor, shall this requirement preclude the contractor from participating in any research and development. Additionally, sale of catalog or standard commercial items are exempt from this requirement.

(k) The contractor shall promptly notify the contracting officer, in writing, if it has been tasked to evaluate or advise the government concerning its own products or activities or those of a competitor in order to ensure proper safeguards exist to guarantee objectivity and to protect the government's interest.

(l) The contractor shall include this requirement in subcontracts of any tier which involve access to information or situations/conditions covered by the preceding paragraphs, substituting "subcontractor" for "contractor" where appropriate.

(m) The rights and remedies described herein shall not be exclusive and are in addition to other rights and remedies provided by law or elsewhere included in this contract.

(n) Compliance with this requirement is a material requirement of this contract.

#### **H.4 Contractor Support Public Trust Determinations**

Per Marine Corps Systems Command Policy Letter 1-09, all Contractor support that require a CAC are required to submit a Standard Form 85P, "Questionnaire for Public Trust Positions," and two copies of DD Form 258 "Applicant Fingerprint Card" to the Command's Security Program office along with a personnel roster of submissions and an addressed Federal Express container addressed to OPM, 1137 Branchton Road, Box 618, Boyers, PA 16018.

The Contractor is responsible for determining when adjudications have been entered by reviewing the notification status of their respective personnel. Once this has been completed, the Contractor may request the issuance of the CAC using the Contract Verification System (CVS) procedures. However, if issues are discovered, the Department of the Navy, Central Adjudication Facility (DONCAF) will place a "No Determination Made" in the Joint Personnel Adjudication System (JPAS) and forward the investigation to the submitting office for the Government to adjudicate.

#### **H. 5 Substitution of Key Personnel**

a. Key personnel definition. Key personnel are understood to be those individuals who were proposed in the Contractor's technical submission, and specifically listed herein, who are necessary to fill the requirements of the task order.

b. The contractor shall assign to this task order those people identified as key personnel and who are necessary to fulfill the requirements of this task order. No substitutions shall be made except in accordance with this clause.

c. Guidance on Substitutions. All substitution requests must be submitted, in writing, at least fifteen (15) days [thirty (30) days if security clearance is to be obtained] in advance of the proposed substitutions to the Contracting Officer.

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d. Requests for Substitutions. All requests for substitutions must provide a detailed explanation of the circumstances necessitating the proposed substitution, and any other information requested by the Contracting Officer. All proposed substitutes must have qualifications that are equal to or higher than the qualifications required of the person to be replaced. The Contracting Officer or his/her authorized representative will evaluate such requests and promptly notify the Contractor of his/her approval or disapproval thereof.

#### **H.6 Post Award Conference**

Within 30 days of the start of performance, the awardee shall organize a Kickoff Meeting to be attended by the COR and contractor personnel to reconcile performance requirements including: detailed WBS, 30-day staffing plan, use of team members/subcontractors, security requirements, funding and management of funds, and quality control measures in response to the Performance Requirements Survey (PRS).

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## SECTION I CONTRACT CLAUSES

### 09RA 52.217-9 -- OPTION TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT. (MAR 2008)

(a) The Government may extend the term of this contract by written notice to the Contractor within 30 days prior to completion of the base period; provided that the Government gives the Contractor a preliminary written notice of its intent to extend at least 60 days before the contract expires. The preliminary notice does not commit the Government to an extension.

(b) If the Government exercises this option, the extended contract shall be considered to include this option clause.

(c) The total duration of this contract, including the exercise of any options under this clause, shall not exceed five years.

### 52.217-8 OPTION TO EXTEND SERVICES (NOV 1999)

The Government may require continued performance of any services with the limits and at the rates specified in the contract. These rates may be adjusted only as a result of revisions to prevailing labor rates provided by the Secretary of Labor. The option provision may be exercised more than once, but the total extension of performance hereunder shall not exceed 6 months. The Contracting Officer may exercise the option by written notice to the Contractor within 14 days.
